The man who commands a squad has the largest personal responsibility in the Cadet Corps.

DUTIES

1. Responsible for the appearance and cleanliness of his men.
2. Sees that his men are properly clothed and equipped. Sees that all equipment issued to the men of his squad is properly cared for.
3. Sees that his men report losses or damage to Government equipment.
4. Inspects each day at the beginning of the period the men's clothing and equipment for fit, cleanliness, press, shine, and proper arrangement.
5. Knows the location of the members of his squad during the period.
6. Sees that his men are properly trained, gives excellent training when he teaches the class and aids others to the best of his abilities when others teach the class.
7. Estimates the capabilities and limitations of his men in order to help his men overcome any weaknesses. To develop to the utmost leadership and military knowledge of all members of his squad.
8. Follows through on all orders of his superiors to see that all orders are properly and efficiently carried out.
9. Makes the maximum use of his assistant so as to develop his qualities of leadership.
10. To look out for and protect the legitimate rights of his men. Sees that able men get their promotions to Cadet First Class. Sees that qualified men receive badges or awards such as marksmanship medals etc.

Leadership does not consist of bullying, shouting, and threatening. Such methods are the methods of a small man playing at being a leader. A leader does exactly that. He leads. He shows the way by example and through excellent training. Do not expect men to do what you can not or will not do. Do demand however, quick and efficient execution of all legal orders. Be firm, but be just. Be sure that you are absolutely right before you discipline a man.

Care and consideration often succeed where stern discipline often fails. Your men must be treated like men not like slaves. Appeal to a man's pride in himself and in the team as a whole. Make your men a proud unit not a beaten one.

SCHOOL OF THE SOLDIER

WITHOUT ARMS:

1. Attention - Position
2. Cadence - Counting
3. Fall In - Normal & Close Interval
4. Facings at a Halt (R-L)

7. March with 15" step (Half Step)

Rules Governing Fair Grounds Range Usage & Rifle Team:

1. Missing Practices:

A cadet may miss two rifle practices without excuse, but if three are missed without excuse, the members will automatically be dropped from the squad.

A cadet may miss 4 rifle practices with legitimate excuse.

2. Missing Matches:

A cadet may miss none of the scheduled matches without legitimate excuse. The legitimacy of the excuse will be determined by the Commandant. In order to receive any school award a cadet must participate in 6 out of 8 matches.

3. Qualification for Team Awards:

A. All new members of the Team will at the end of the season receive their Cadet Ribbon for the rifle team.

B. All second year men will receive ribbon attachments designating number of years of participation.

C. In order to qualify for school awards the following must be attained:

Varsity - Average score at end of season for 8 matches of 155.

J.V. - Average score at end of season for 8 matches of 120.

"B" Team - Average score at end of season for 8 matches of 85.

4. Use of Rifle Range at Fair Grounds:

A. Entering the Fair Grounds - each member will go directly to the range, not to any of the other buildings - if no one is at the range, wait in front of the Range building.

B. When firing on Saturdays each member will enter the Fair Grounds at the designated time and go directly to the Range House.

Upon completion of firing you will go directly off of the Fair Grounds.

C. While on the Range - no members will tamper with or go into any of the material stored on the sides of the Range.

1st occurrence - warning.

2nd occurrence - expulsion from team.

D. Conduct in Range - will be quiet and orderly.

E. All range safety procedures will be followed. Any violation of Range safety will:

1st - warrant removal from Range.

2nd - expulsion from team.

Rules Governing Fair Grounds Range Usage & Rifle Team (Continued):

- F. Conduct on range by Rifle Team - This team is designed to do one thing - practice so that we may win our Rifle matches. Any misconduct, excessive laughter, clowning, wise-cracking, ect., is not necessary nor will it be allowed. If it is necessary to warn a member of this team more than once then that member will be dropped from the team. Remember, when you are practicing, you think about Rifle Marksmanship; if you don't think this is important, get off of the team! Those of you who do and want to make this Roseville's winning year, get in and win this year's league, you can do it if you want to.
